

## **PARTNERS PROGRAM FAQ'S**

**Q) I've heard about the Power Serve & partner prospects, but I don't really understand.**

**What is the Power Serve?**

A) All TGCS students (elementary, middle, & high school) will participate in service projects this spring during the first two weeks of March. This is our way of giving back to the community & TGCS will be recognized as a school centered on Christianity.

**Q) What is the Partners Program & what are we asking them to do?**

A) The Partners Program is churches, businesses, and organizations within our community that want to partner with TGCS financially.

**Q) What do you want me to do?**

A) Agree to contact partner prospects that you think would like to share with TGCS. We will have a packet with information on our school, as well as information on our Power Serve project to give to prospective partners at the January 7<sup>th</sup> kickoff and in the business office, thereafter.

**Q) Who do I know that would want to partner with us?**

A) How about Uncle Benny's Barber shop? He could give a donation & have his name on the Power Serve t-shirts the students will be wearing. Or maybe Al's automotive shop; you know, the guy you trust to work on your old car (and maybe see a little too often) Or your congregation. Churches have many causes they support – why not support our school which is a strong member of the community with Christian families that help the community.

**Q) So, all I have to do is approach a congregation and/or businesses I am in contact with and share a packet with them?**

A) YES!! You will be able to pick up a packet & deliver it to the partner prospect personally & ask them to consider this partnership.

**Q) Will I have to do this every year?**

A) NO, we will be able to send out a letter next year asking the partner if they want to renew their partnership.

**Q) How will this help our school? Will this really amount to much financially?**

A) YES!! Think of it this way: if 250 families approach one partner prospect & each of those prospects shared \$100, our school would have \$25,000 for improvements to our programs. Many families will submit more than one prospect & some partner will donate more. See how this can help our school!!!

**Q) What kind of service projects will the students be working on?**

A) This November & December we will be discussing types of projects & firming up the roster of individuals to be organizers for their child's class.
